10 Junior faculty participants in the Vice President's Clinical and Translational (VPCAT) program. All eight junior faculty who have completed the program have obtained external research funding.

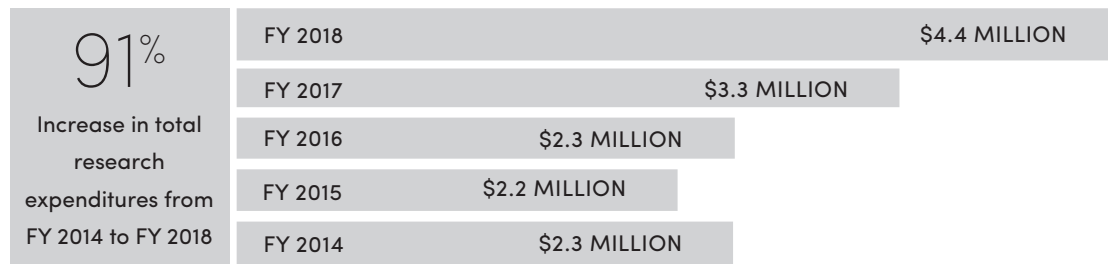
